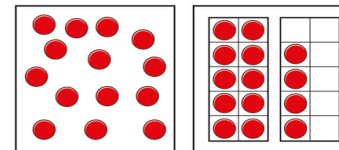
Don't forget to practise your math fluency on the White Rose Maths application.
