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


The Wheels Off The Bus

As the girl at the front makes a rather rude sound. The wheels on the bus go round and round, The man in the suit just looked and frowned All through the town.


As the gran at the back gives a massive huge cough. And the toddler dribbled out some bright blue froth. The wheels on the bus are falling off, All through the town.
