- Share 12 cubes equally between 4 boxes.

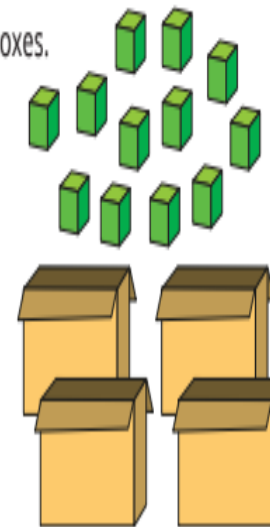
