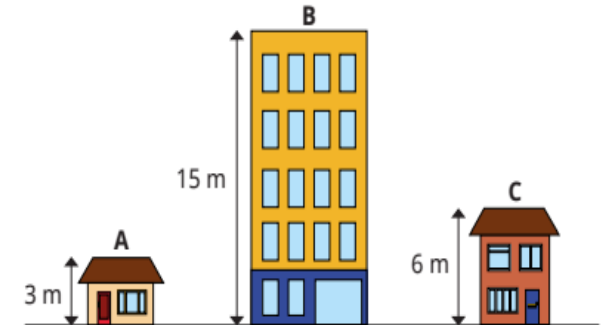
Challenge:
