## SUNNYHILL POLLING STATION

Dear Parents/Carers,

I am writing with arrangements for 5<sup>th</sup> May when Sunnyhill will be used as a polling station for the local elections. **This year we will only have Year 6 pupils and staff on site at school on 5<sup>th</sup> May, all other pupils will be given work to complete at home.**

Last year, during the Mayoral election, we trialled having groups of children from different year groups on site during the polling day. However this proved unworkable going forward due to difficulties in maintaining segregation between the election officials and school staff/children from different year groups.

**All children from Nursery to Year 5 will be given work to do at home on Google Classroom (KS2) or via the website (EYFS & KS1) on 5<sup>th</sup> May.**

Pupils in Year 6 entitled to a free school meal will be provided with a school packed lunch, all children should bring a packed lunch on that day or request a school packed lunch by Thursday 28<sup>th</sup> April.

Parents/carers of pupils entitled to free school meals in years Reception to Year 5 may collect a free school packed lunch on the day. If you would like to do so, please inform the school office by Thursday 28<sup>th</sup> April.
