Safer Valley Road

There was fantastic news this week from the Safer Valley Road Campaign, which aims to reduce traffic volumes and speeds in our local area to tackle air pollution and road danger. Lambeth Council has decided to turn the neighbourhood surrounding Sunnyhill School (between Streatham High Road, Leigham Court Road and Streatham North) into a low traffic neighbourhood. This means that the whole area will be redesigned to prevent rat-running traffic and prioritise pedestrians and cyclists. The changes will be made within the next three years and should make our local area safer for children walking and cycling to school and improve air quality in and around the school.
