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Family Learning

Here is our family learning offer for this term. A leaflet is available from the school office.

Phonics- Part 1 Wednesday 25th September 2019 9-10am
Stay & Learn Thursday 26th September 2019 9-10am:
(open to Reception parents)

At school your child will have a daily phonics session. Phonics is the relationship between letters and the sounds of words. It helps your child learn how to read and write. Your child will begin by learning the sounds of the letters of the alphabet.

Phonics- Part 2 Wednesday 15th January 2020 9-10am
Stay & Learn Thursday 16th January 2020 9-10am: (open to Reception parents)

In this workshop we introduce more sounds of the alphabet. This workshop will show you how we teach the more difficult sounds of the alphabet and ways to help your child at home.

Both of the Phonics workshops will be followed with an in-class Stay & Learn session so that parents/carers can join the Early Years Team and learn with their child.
