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English

Focus Texts: Leon and The Place Between by Angela McAllister', The First Drawing by Mordicai Gerstein, The BFG by Roald Dahl, Twelfth Night by William Shakespeare. Reading: We read every day using a variety of texts focussing on fluency and inference questions. Writing: We write narratives, information texts, diaries and letters. We learn to improve our grammar and expand our vocabulary.

Maths

This term we will be focusing on number skills and understanding. We will build our understanding of place value and improve our written and mental arithmetic with addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. We will consolidate our knowledge of the 2, 5 and 10 times tables so that we know them in order, out of order and the division facts.

Science

Our topics are rocks and lights. We will compare and group different kinds of rocks and describing how fossils are formed. We will understand that light is needed order to see things; that light is reflected from surfaces and that light from the sun

Autumn Term Curriculum

Computing

We will begin to understand the inputs, processes, and outputs of digital devices. We will compare digital and non-digital devices. Then look at computer networks and discover the benefits of connecting devices in a network.

History and Geography

We will learn about The Tiber river and use maps to learn about lines of latitude and longitude. We will learn about The Stone Age and develop our skills as historians and

Modern Foreign Language (Spanish)

We will be build our understanding of the following topics: greetings, introducing ourselves, asking and answering about feelings, animals, colours and more.

PSHE

Being me in my world: Get to know each other and create a positive classroom environment. Celebrating differences: See how our words and actions can bring us

PΕ

This term will do invasion sports and build body control in Football, Netball, Basketball and Gymnastics. We will also look to build teamwork skills and understand how to be

Art and DT

In D.T. we will make sliding mechanisms and use these to create a product. We will then look at the art of the Stone Age with a focus on drawing.
