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### English

Focus Texts: Hugo Cabret, The Templeton Twins, The 3 little Pigs (with a twist) and The Boy in the Tower

Reading: We read our class novel every day and have a class book corner with lots of new books. We are also visiting the library every week.

**Writing:** Our writing is linked to our focus texts. This term we are writing formal letters, character analysis, film critiques and narratives.

Maths: This term we will learning fractions, decimals, percentages, area, perimeter, volume and statistics. We will continue to make links across the curriculum and further developing our arithmetic, reasoning and problem solving skills.

### Science:

This term we will be learning about natural evolution and inheritance by investigating what happens during natural selection, how animals and plants adapt to their environments and how living things have evolved over time.

# Spring Term Curriculum

**Computing:** This term, we will be exploring variables in programming, how to make changes and improve a game and design our own games. We will use algorithms and then make changes to improve our games.

### History/Geography:

In history, we will be learning about The Industrial Revolution. We will consider what life was like before the revolution, what impact it had on the environment and consider arguments if the revolution made positive or negative impact on our lives.

**PE:** We will be learning and practising skills in gymnastics and basketball. We will be working towards mini games and competitions.

## Modern Foreign Language (Spanish): We

will be learning numbers and dates in Spanish. We will also be learning sports, nouns and developing the ability to have a short conversation with someone in Spanish about our opinions of different sports..

**PSHE:** The themes of our lessons this term are 'Dreams and Goals' and 'Healthy Me'. We will make our own goals and targets, consider the steps we need to take to reach them and recognise our achievements.

## Art/DT:

In art we will be studying how art can influence people, looking at images from environmental photographer of the year as well as exploring layered print inspired by our sustainable development goal. **RE:** In RE this term I will be learning about 'Expressing faith through the Arts' and 'What is the Qur'an?'

#### Music:
