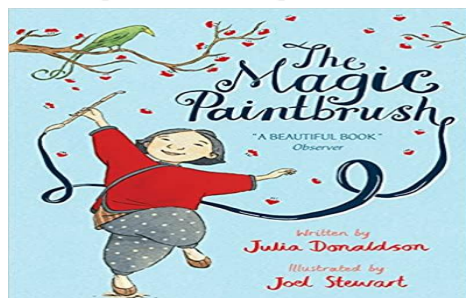
## Let's get building
