English

Focus Texts: Kaspar Prince of Cats by Michael Morpurgo; The Man who Walked Between the Towers by Mordica Gerstein; High Rise Mystery Sharna Jackson.

Reading: We have daily whole class reading sessions using extracts from fiction and non-fiction texts as well as poetry.

Maths: This term we are focusing on developing our knowledge of decimals and percentages, money, properties of shapes, converting units of measure, position and direction as well as statistics. We will also be working on our times tables to ensure that we develop speed and fluency with tables up to 12x including the division facts.



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Science: Our first topic this term is **Living things and their habitats**. We will be looking at the differences in the life cycles of a mammal, an amphibian, an insect and a bird; describing the life process of reproduction in some plants and animals. Our second topic is **Animals including humans** where we will describe the changes as humans develop to old age.

Summer Term Curriculum

Computing: Our first topic this term is 'Programming - selection in physical computing'. In the second half of this term, we we will be learning about 'Programming - selection in quizzes'.

History/Geography: In the first half of this term, we will be focusing on our History topic - Local History. We will look at how Streatham changed over time and what effect did WW2 have on Streatham. During the second part of this term, we will focus on Geography where we will be looking at counties in the UK, geographical regions and their identifying human and physical

PE: This term, we will be working on developing our skills in gymnastics, athletics and tennis.

Modern Foreign Language (Spanish): We will be working on developing our vocabulary through speaking, listening, reading and writing in the following topics: words used on an ID card and sentences about the seaside.

Art/DT: In Art, we will be focusing on photography where we will be looking at old photograph of streatham and comparing them to the modern ones which we will be taking. In DT, we will be cooking.

PSHE: Our weekly Jigsaw sessions will be focusing on' Relationships' and 'Changing me'.

RE: This term, we will be learning about Stories of Christianity and about Belief in our Community.
