Please see below a message from Ms Trewhella.

The use of unkind words, repeatedly, or using difference negatively are forms of bullying. If and when we see it, we will take a very robust approach. We tell children that they must speak to an adult if something goes wrong but sometimes children are reluctant. If a child discloses worries to you, please come into school and speak to a member of staff. If we don't know about problems, we can't help!

Today, I have re-circulated the contact list. This list tells you who to speak to about different questions that you might have in the school. Over the next week, these contacts will be displayed around school too.

Please remember that we operate an 'open door' policy for quick questions or urgent concerns (e.g. safeguarding). For all routine conversations, please make an appointment with your child's class teacher or a member of the leadership team, depending on the query.
