English

Science:

This term our science will be focused on biology. We will be learning about evolution and inheritance, how organisms have adapted to their environments, and how scientists classify them into groups.

Spring Term Curriculum

Computing: This term, we will be using scratch to programme games, and creating spreadsheets. We will be working in collaborative pairs throughout our computing lessons, working together to develop our skills and understanding of programming.

History/Geography:

In history we are learning about the Industrial Revolution, why it began in England, and its effects on Streatham and the world today. In geography we will be looking further at the

Modern Foreign Language (Spanish): We will be continuing to build sentences in Spanish, using what we have learned so far and adding vocabulary for fun activities.

PE: We will be learning and practising skills in tennis and basketball. We will be working towards mini games and competitions in both, using simple tactics.
