Reading: Reading is practised every day in our phonics and reading. We have a daily story time. Children are encouraged to read in every lesson, when possible and in the book corner. We have weekly visits to the school library. We love reading!

Writing: Our writing is linked to our focus text. This term we will be writing profiles, fact files, ...

Maths: This term we will be learning about:

Multiplication and division, fractions, geometry, position and direction, place value (within 100), measurement, money and time.

PSHE:

This term we will be learning about '**Relationships**' and '**Changing Me**'.

Summer Term Curriculum

Computing:

Creating media - digital writing, using a computer to create and format text.

Programming animations - design and programme the movement of a character on screen to tell stories.

Science:

Plants - Identify and name a variety of common wild and garden plants, deciduous and evergreen trees.

Describe the basic structure of common flowering plants and trees.

Humans - Identify, name and draw basic human body parts. Say which part of the body is associated with each smell, sight, taste, hearing and touch.

Geography:

London - Fieldwork and observation skills to study the school's geography; Human geography features in the local environment; compass points, North, South, East and West.

Beyond London - World maps and the continents and oceans.

History:

Civilisation - significant historical events, people and places in the local area; the history of Sunnyhill School
